Slide through friction

Friction is a force that resists motion between two bodies in contact and can be found all around us. We depend on friction to keep our feet from sliding out from under us and to keep us safe. Theertha of Grade 8 understood this by using an inclined plane and spring balance. Through this experimental learning, she concluded that Friction depends on the nature of surfaces in contact.
