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Computer Science Literacy Day

The students were excited and were filled with the urge to learn more about their body systems.



Directing the way

The excitement level was high and set the ground for the understanding conversion of units and its real-life applications.

The tactics of advertising were not discussed but through their exposure to various advertisements, the children were observed to have adopted different techniques to sell the product. The activity turned out to be a great experience as it helped build on their practical knowledge thereby seamlessly breaking into the concepts of advertising and marketing.


this activity, the 5th graders went on to make some awareness posters to spread the importance of protecting historical monuments and public property to their seniors and juniors.
