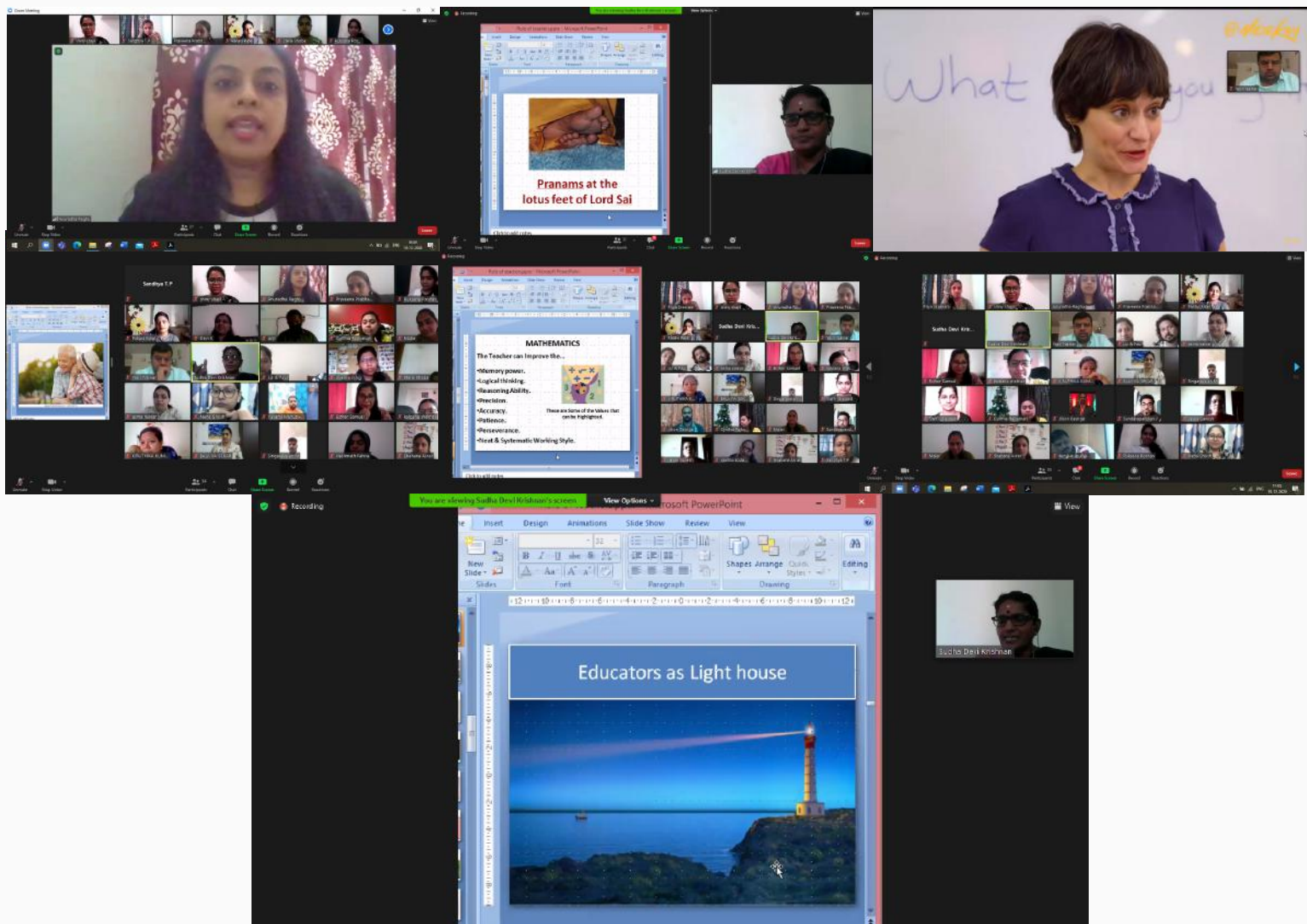
An educator is like a lighthouse. Standing up front and tall for all the students to see. Guiding their way making sure they all stay clear of obstacles up ahead.

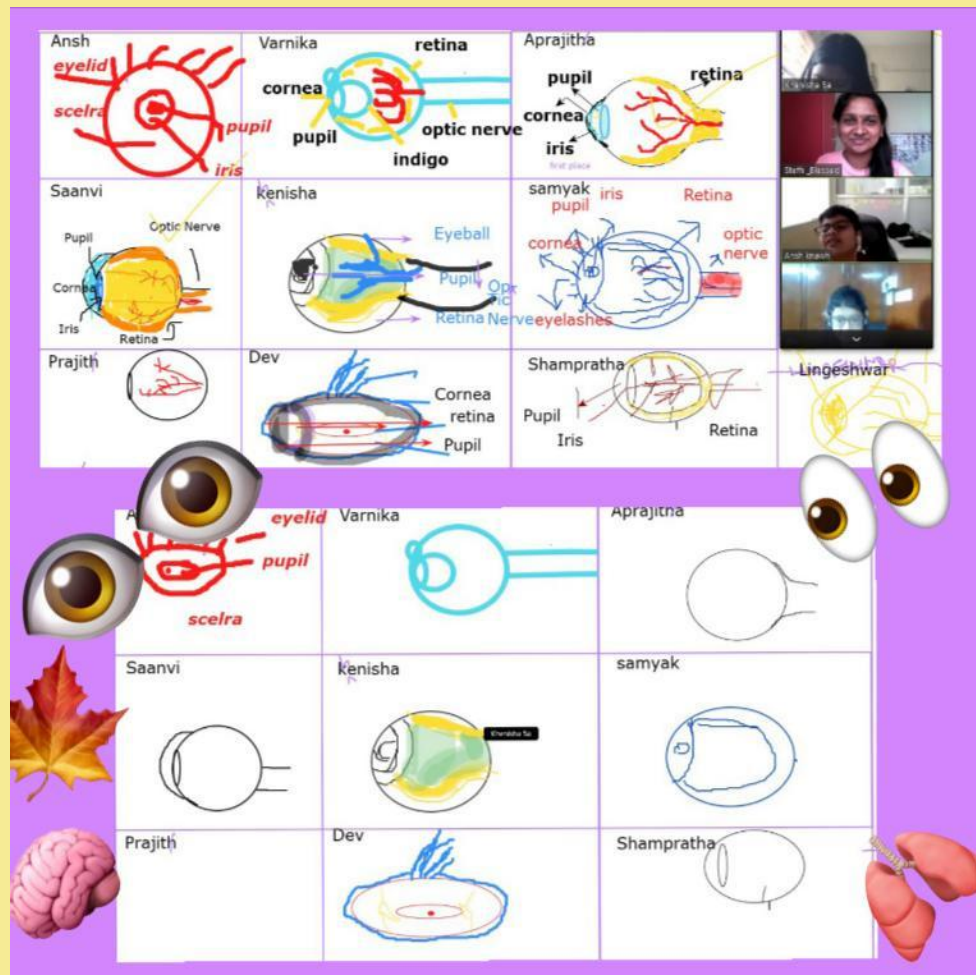
The workshop concluded with valuable insights into the teaching aspects by our Chairman sir Mr. Yasir Nainar followed by our Principal Asma ma’am.
