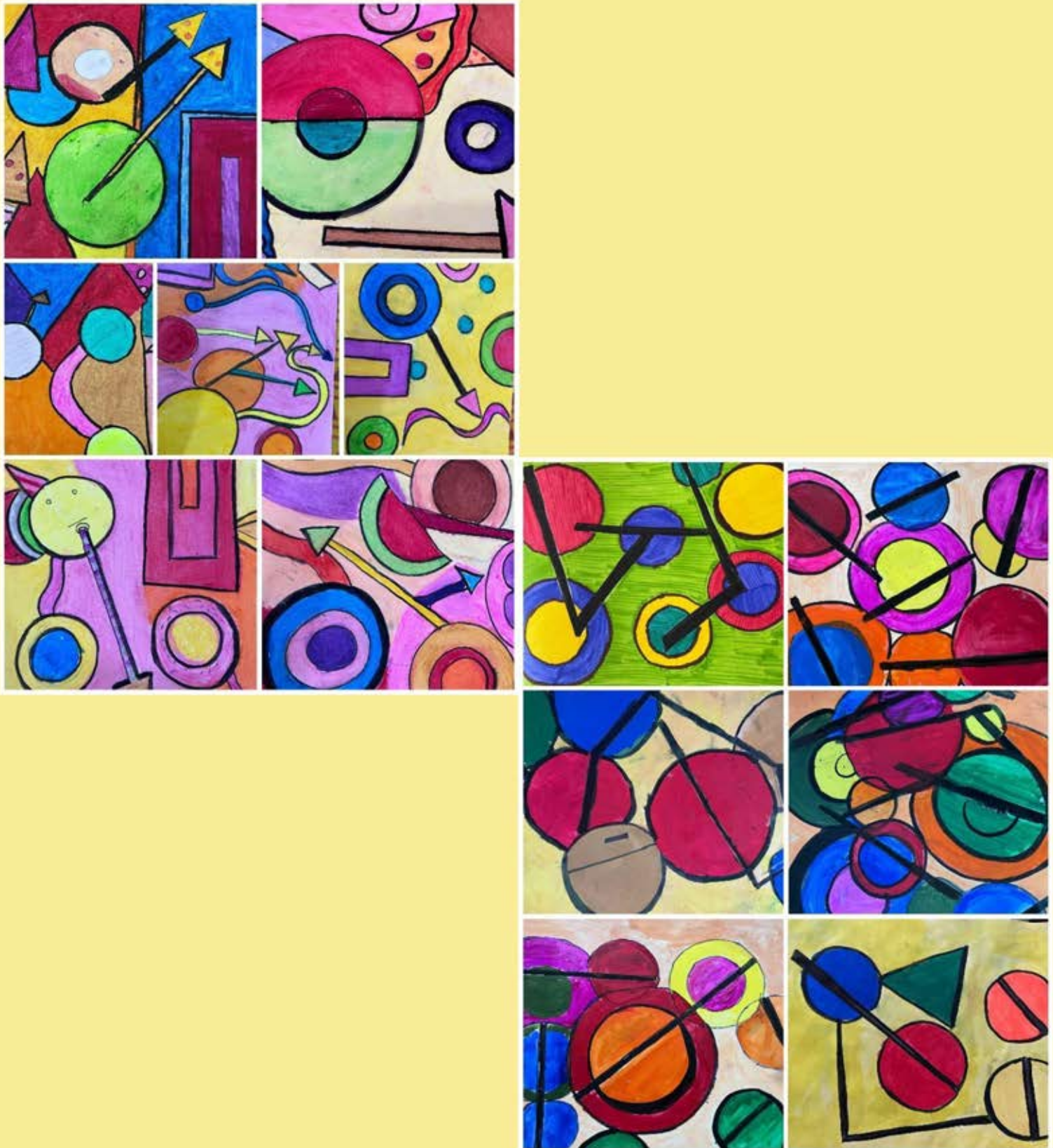


Grade 2: Drip Art with Jackson Pollock Technique
