Find the Interjections

Ms. Preethi I(Grade 6 English Educator, BHIS)



Our students were made to play the game, "Find the Interjections in the Box". The students had to first learn what interjections are and their correct usage. After which, students were made to find the first interjection in the crowd. Once the interjection was found, everyone was supposed to express the interjection out loud along with the correct facial expressions. For example, the first interjection they had to find was 'hurrah'. Once they had circled the word, the whole class of 20 went, "HURRAH!". It was delightful to see the students having so much fun and learning at the same time. The fun did not stop there. They went on to give their own examples of where the interjection could be used. The activity forced the students to understand what they were learning and make use of other skills like, vocal skill, drama skill and linguistic creativity



Practical Geometry

Paper folding activity is an art form that helps children to develop their math skills. Children drew a line parallel to a given line through a point outside the line by paper folding method. In a rectangular sheet, they drew a line I and marked a point P outside the line. Then they folded vertically to get a perpendicular line. folded along Again, same horizontally about the point P. Darkened the horizontal crease using pencil and labeled it as m. This line m is parallel to line 1. They also verified the properties of angles formed when parallel lines are intersected two transversal.



Lab Activity



V.Sanjay Grade 8 CBSE

The entire subject revolves on the day we spent in a lab studying sound and its vibration. Luckily, we went to the lab. Me, Kavin, and Lohith travelled to the lab with Sir Singaravelan, who organised the activity. After that, we all went to a tuning fork, which was cool. The first thing we did was to test it using a rubber stick to create vibration. We could see the vibration with our naked eyes, and depending on the size of the tuning fork, we could hear a higher or lower sound. Then, we kept the vibrating fork close to the bob to count the number of oscillations it would take using a timer. Our teacher counted the oscillations. Additionally, Swathi instructed on this by engaging us in this activity, and Bhavya Ma'am was the final person to inspect and enquire. Following this, we once more experimented the vibration using various tuning fork sizes. After this, we finally recognised that sound flows across media in the same manner, even in tuning forks. We also realised that frequency varies depending on length.





Train the Brain Activity

It can help with memory and anxiety or depression."The topic was Memory skills - There are numerous strategies that can effectively improve memory, enhance recall, and increase retention of information. The session focused on memory and concentration exercises for the brain, as well as Midbrain Activation Techniques. Our Principal Ms. Asma Nainar, Academic Co-ordinator and Physics faculty Ms. Manjula and I were part of this activity. The activity began with the briefing of Brain exercise and its uses. Our Principal ma'am initiated the first Brain exercise, which was observed and repeated by Grade 9 students. The students thoroughly enjoyed the session by repeating 5 to 6 Brain exercises demonstrated to them.










