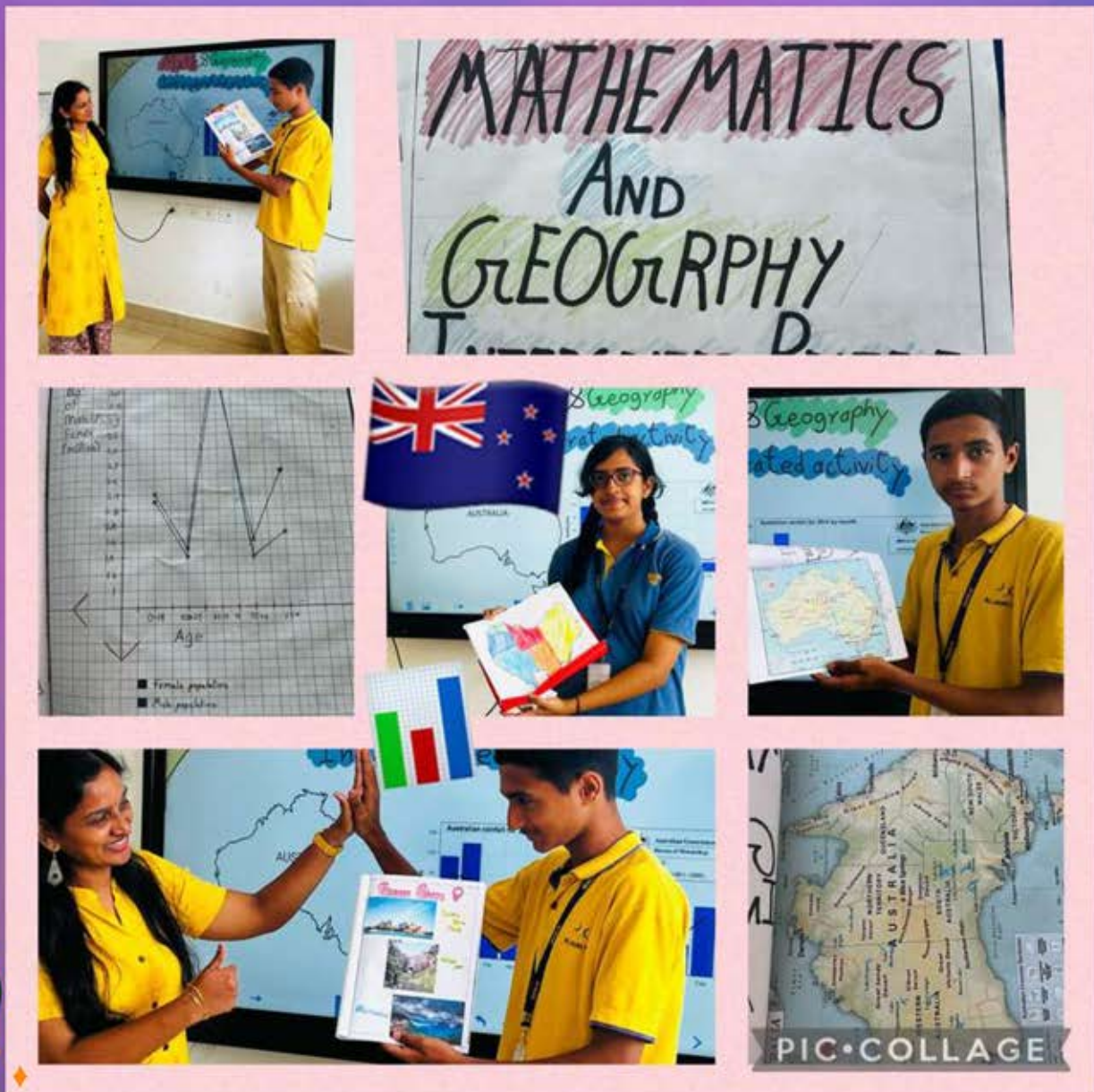
Integrated Learning

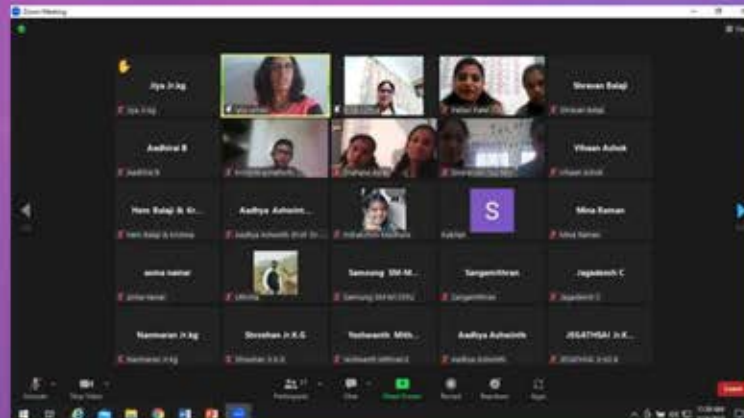
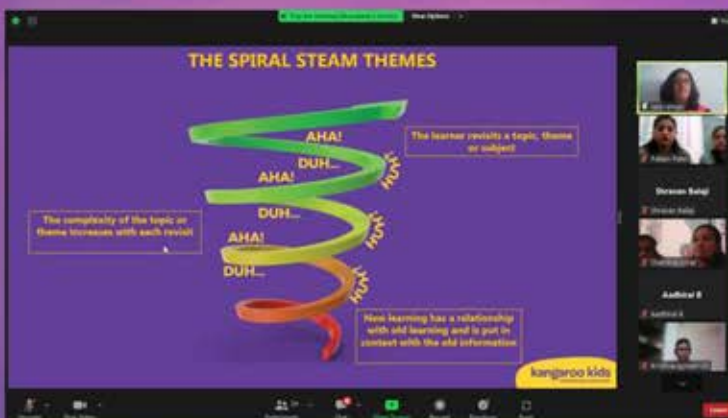
