Place Value craft

A place value chart is a diagram that helps the students to find and compare the place value of the digits in numbers. Each digit has its place value in the number, which tells its position. To learn the large numbers without any confusion, we use this chart to arrange them into periods. Students of Grade 5, as a part of learning, did a Place value chart to learn about Indian and International number system. In this activity, students drew Caterpillar, Octopus and filled it with the whole numbers. Students were able to recognize the value of a digit based on its location within a number. It helped the students to understand the relationship between place value of Indian and International number system.










GERMINATION OF SEED

The word germination comes from the Latin germinationem, "a sprouting forth or budding."

Germination of seed can be defined as the process by which a new plant grows from a single seed in the presence of water, air and warmth. This activity involved studying the germination of a seed by the students who have shown great interest in the same. The activity included placing the seeds in a moist piece of cotton wool for two days and observing the growth of the seed on each day. Through this activity students learnt how different environmental conditions affect the process of germination which was evident enough by presence of germination in few seeds and absence in others at the end of 2 days.







Greatest and Smallest Numbers

Students of Grade 6, as a part of learning, did a hands-on activity to learn about Forming greatest and smallest numbers using flash cards. Students were divided into groups and activities were assigned to them. In this activity, students used flash cards with different digits to form the greatest and smallest numbers. Each group tried to get the greatest number by arranging the flash cards in descending order. Thus, the students applied their understanding of place value to form the smallest or the greatest number by playing a fun game. It helped the students to gain hands-on experience to compare numbers in an efficient manner.

ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION OF INTEGERS USING COUNTERS

Integers are collections of numbers that include Positive, and negative numbers along with zero. The effect of positive and negative numbers in the real world is different. In most cases, they are used to illustrate two contradictory situations. Integers are used for players' scores in golf, football, and hockey tournaments, movie, or song ratings; in banks, credits and debits are represented as positive and negative numbers. Students of Grade 7, as a part of learning, did a hands-on activity to learn about Addition and subtraction of Integers. Students were divided into groups and activities were assigned to them. In this activity, students used two different colour counters to model the addition and subtraction of integers. Each group tried to solve the problem by interacting among themselves. Students understood the rules necessary to solve problems and recognized the relation between subtracting and adding two integers.
