ANGLE SUM PROPERTY OF A POLYGON

The primary aim of this student-led project was to comprehend and demonstrate the Angle Sum Property through hands-on activities, collaborative discussions, and practical applications. By exploring various polygons, the students sought to gain a deeper understanding of geometric principles and develop problem-solving skills.

The fundamental concept, which states that the sum of interior angles in any polygon is equal to the product of $(n-2)$ and 180 degrees, became the focal point of an engaging learning experience.

The students successfully validated the Angle Sum Property for various polygons, reinforcing their understanding of the relationship between the number of sides and the interior angles. Not only did they grasp the theoretical aspects, but they also gained insights into the practical implications of this geometric principle.

Through this hands-on exploration of the Angle Sum Property, students not only enhanced their knowledge of geometry but also developed critical thinking and collaborative skills.
