The students suggested measuring each side of the court and adding up the lengths.

They enthusiastically measured the length and width of the court, adding the measurements to find the perimeter. This hands-on activity not only helped them understand the concept but also reinforced their understanding of basic measurement units.

As the activity concluded, the students were excited to share what they had learned. They had not only discovered the importance of shapes and measurements but also realized that math is all around us, even on the basketball court. This learning will surely stay with them as they continue to explore the world of mathematics.
