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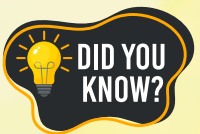
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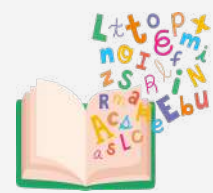

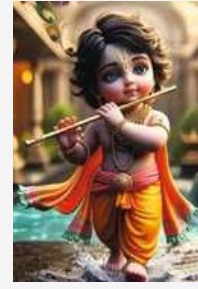

KG Art Corner: A Burst of Creativity from Our Youngest Artists

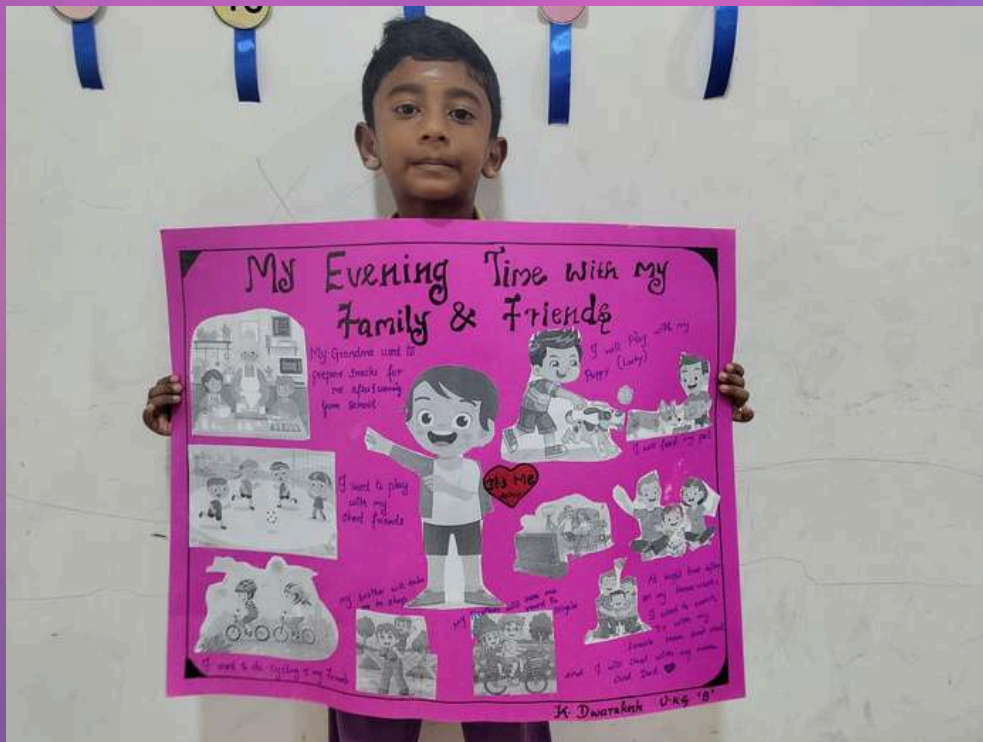

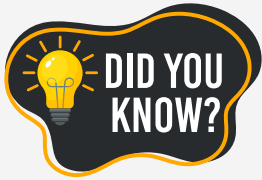

FACTS ABOUT MUSIC

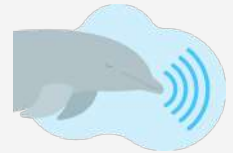
Musical Superpower
